

How to Register for Orange Central 2022:

Our immersion weekend is happening during Syracuse University's homecoming weekend, which we call <u>Orange Central!</u> Alumni, current students and friends are all welcome to participate, and several of the events we've planned for the weekend are part of the Orange Central program, and require separate registration and payment. If you pre-register for Orange Central by <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 6th</u> you will get access to reduced Early Orange pricing on signature events! - 1. Navigate to the Orange Central 2022 Pre-Registration Link
- 2. Fill in your contact information, class year, School/College (Maxwell), graduation date (G'##), dietary restrictions and t-shirt size, etc.
